

Golf Committee Meeting Report, November 6, 2024

Here are the highlights, in no order.

Diane French was elected Committee Chair. Denise Orthen was elected Vice Chair. Kathy Langston was elected Secretary.

Scott Anderson: Both courses are open and look great. It was a tough month of October due to heat but now cool nights. The PV sprinkler system is complete. A question was raised if it is still necessary to keep the white hole facilitators in place or does this damage the edge of the hole when raised and replaced. It was decided we would keep them. He will take a closer look at new holes being cut. Some bare spots would still fill in but the October heat and cool nights have impacted. Should improve.

Joey Jones: New merchandise is arriving: Skechers shoes, and clubs. Don Ceremeli has been hired as the Pro Shop Assistant. Working on new paint and reorganization of the goods in the shop. Re standardizing different ways we sign up for golf: paper on counters, Chelsea and Golf Genius ... likely not good idea to make changes at this time

Jon Griglak: Patrick Simard is new Pro Shop Assistant. Rounds Played are slightly down but similar to last year. Actual to budget will have slight variance. Jonas System will be implemented once the server is successfully based in the Cloud. A step by step process for using Jonas will come In The Know. Swing Into Golf was very successful with great participation. The money raised will be used toward new golf tee markers. Another Swing Into Golf may be done in the spring as sendoff for Snow Birds and end of regular golf season. Rangers will all be trained in the next few weeks and will include the use of the AEDs. John and Joey will be doing some ride-alongs to be sure they are performing consistent duties.

Communication Committee: Completed all their documents included in the Golf Book. Their goals will be shared with the Committee in December.

Board Liaison Report: Marty Neilson reported that our budget looks good, \$250K better than budget. It appears we are on target to meet budget. The \$15.4M budget was approved at the last board meeting.

General Managers Report: Steve Hardesty reported Swing Into Golf was a great success; final income will be available in next few days.
