Here are the highlights - in no order.

<u>Scott:</u> reported sprinkler project at PV will be done later in Oct. will be on budget with money left for programming software. Practice area netting we are still waiting on; golf ball protections screens and damaged poles have been replaced. Water usage overview was done see notes, repairs done to irrigation system. Much course work has been done, removed the bunker on CW 18. October will be OVERSEEDING, we will open to cart path only until proper timing for best results, then we will open with new flags. Bunker repair continues in the rotation set up with so many per month. Scott has an employee who just celebrated 30 years at Sun Lakes thank you Miguel Vargas, WOW. Continued course investment paying off. The question asked why we can't overseed one course and then when it opens do the other. Weather and Mother Nature may bring cold or frost on the back side so cannot change this.

Jon: Introduced Joey Jones our new head Pro at PV. Update on Jonas replacing Chelsea, Pro Shop staff will be trained Oct 15- 17, they will then get information out to HO, YouTube videos and written checklist(more to come!) Annual Memberships will go on sale mid-October. Rangers collected cash over summer, continued training for the program and hiring will be in October. Budget in good shape currently but a few tough months ahead. Rounds are looking good at both courses, over at PV in Sept, and just slightly under at CW.

<u>Joey</u>: Is working to learn the ropes, has enjoyed meeting people and appreciates patience as he learns who everyone is, had reps in to for an Inventory review, we be sending a lot of outdated merchandise back and we are getting a credit back, that will enable him to bring in new, a big sale also coming soon.

<u>Golf Committee and Pros</u>: would like to remind all golfers it is your responsibility to bring in and show your HO card especially as we have new people and will be hiring a few more part time clerks. Everywhere else, Admin, restaurants, fitness center we must show cards to prove we are up to date on dues, and active, golfers are no different. Please just show your cards at sign in

<u>Old Business:</u> Rates were approved at Sept Board meeting, Updated Golf Book was shown and ready, printing will be in house with good savings. There is a new sign off sheet that each golfer will sign they understand the rules and policies of the course and what the consequences are for warnings. The league games and calendar will be separate and should be on all league web sites. Each league should have one person talking to pro shop about their game that week to stop confusion. PV course remeasurement done and course adjusted down slightly due to changes, new cards will be ordered as soon as we are out.

NEW Business: Pat thanked Gregg Lorimore and Jim Rumpler for their service and dedication to the golf committee as they rotated off. They both contributed to subcommittee work also. The golf committee interviewed for a New At Large committee member opening and Kathy Langston was chosen, she will be recommended to the Board for approval . Sandy Worden will replace Pat Shouse for the CWLG, and John Kane will replace Jim Rumpler for PVCL, these will go to the Board for approval.

Sub committees will meet and finalize years work as new goals will be set starting in Nov. The committee will continue to use and update the 5-year strategic plan that includes our water plan also. Goals annually will be looked at as will the charter.
