

## CLGA GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

DATE and TIME: November 7, 2024, 1:43 PM

PRESIDENT, Zara Logan called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Karen Fischer moved to approve the minutes posted on the website from the General Membership Meeting on May 9, 2024, and was seconded. The motion passed.

BUDGET for 2024-25 – Zara Logan: the budget is posted on CLGA's website and copies were on the tables.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

RINGER AWARDS - Nadine Sanders handed out prize money for last year's ringers. Fifty-eight members participated making up four flights. The winners' names will be posted on the website.

STATE MEDALLION - Mary Anne Lofquist explained she picks four days a year to enter CLGA members' scores in the State Medallion tournament. This year's winners are Kathryn Campbell for gross and Billie Seiberling for net. They will play in the State Medallion at Oakwood in January 2025.  
The 2025 play dates are January 2, February 13, March 6, and March 13<sup>th</sup>.

MOST IMPROVED GOLFER - Zara Logan, president, announced Rita Healy as the most improved golfer for 2024.

CAGD—Kathy Langston wasn't able to attend. Zara Logan explained that CAGD stands for Central Arizona Golf District. She thanked members who have signed up, and if you didn't, you still can because the CAGD year begins in January. Membership includes playing tournaments at other courses throughout the year. Currently, there are 1300 women members. To join, give \$8.00 to Lisa Mohoric (our new CAGD representative). More CAGD information is posted on our website.

MEMBER-AT-LARGE PROPOSAL - Sandy Eeds explained we would like to add a Member-AT-Large position to the existing board making 11 members. That person would be the voice of the general membership, bringing concerns, suggestions, and feedback from the CLGA members. She would assist board members in executing ad-hoc assignments as they arise. Examples: Assisting with Logo Wear orders and helping the event chairs. The position would be a two-year term. The proposed change to the Bylaws is posted on the bulletin board inside the ladies' restroom. After 30 days a vote by members will take place via the web. If anyone is interested in the Member-At-Large position talk to Zara Logan.

LOGO WEAR - The order form for the CLGA logo wear is now on the website. We need a minimum order of 20 for any of the items. Once we get the items you will be notified and you can pay with Zelle or check. You cannot use chits for payment.

AFTERNOON TEE TIMES - Karen Fischer: This is a one-year trial and no afternoon play on luncheon days. Each week you will receive an email from Jon to select your shotgun starting time (morning or afternoon). There are only five starting times in the afternoon limited to 20 players. \*\*Note - You are only selecting your starting time. You may select any hole that has that starting time. This does not mean you will play that designated hole or play with the players in that slot. Only guarantees your starting time\*\*. Travis makes the pairings on Wednesday and if you have to cancel do so by Tuesday. Posting for Thursday's scores will be posted on Sunday.

## NEW BUSINESS

INTRODUCTION of BOARD AND COMMITTEE CHAIRS -Zara Logon announced they are posted on the website.

INTRODUCTION of NEW MEMBERS - Patti Hegenbarth introduced 19 new members. Each new member will receive a bag tag. Unfortunately, not all the bag tags were ready before this meeting. Apologies if you did not get one at today's meeting you will be presented with one later. The new members will receive another gift at the Christmas party. A new member orientation with their Big Sisters will be held later.

CHRISTMAS SCRAMBLE/LUNCHEON - Ruby Meyer: The Christmas lunch will be on December 12th in the San Tan Ballroom. Members must sign up for the luncheon and golf on the website by midnight on December 5th. Catering must know the count five days before our luncheon. We can't make any additions or refunds after that date. If you find out you can't play before the deadline of the 5<sup>th</sup> call Ruby (not the treasurer, Pat McRoberts). Everyone is requested to bring unwrapped toys that morning for Toys for Tots. Sun Lakes firemen will pick up these toys at our luncheon. Ruby and Pat Shouse need six volunteers to bring a small toy for the table centerpieces and these toys will also be donated to Toys for Tots. Husbands will collect the Toys for Tots on Thursday morning and provide drinks on holes 2 and 12. A vote was taken to donate the 50/50 money to Neighbors Who Care.

WEBSITE - Sandy Eeds: A new site on our website; "Tools and Forms", click on it for ordering logo wear, expense reimbursement, etc. For questions click on "Send a Memo to CLGA". Your question will be sent to the person responsible for the answer and you should get an answer in two days. Sandy also follows up. Everything is on the website: member list, board members, chair members, committees, calendar, luncheon sign-up, and instructions on how to put the CLGA website on your phone. She thanked Pat McRoberts and Zara Logan for all the time they gave for setting up payments through Zelle.

HANDICAP REPORT – Nancy Hermanson: Introduced member Sue Kish, Nelda Machutas' daughter. Each playday you get two scorecards and use Golf Genius which means three out of four keep the scores. The two scorecards and Golf Genius must match individual and team scores! Use your gross scores. If you are playing in the afternoon and the pro shop is closed you can hand your scorecard in on Saturday or Sunday and tell them it was for the CLGA Thursday game. Nancy posts all the scores for Thursday's play day. Post your scores on other days if you play at least nine holes. GHIN uses the differential. It uses your scores for whatever holes you played, and takes into consideration your handicap, how you were playing on that day, and what the weather was like.

Playday winners will probably be posted on Sunday.

HANDICAP TOURNAMENT – Karen Fischer: It starts November 21<sup>st</sup> and the second round is on December 5<sup>th</sup>. We skip a week because of Thanksgiving. Golf Genius will probably not be used on those days. The tournament is your first-day handicap plus your second-day handicap.
