

Del Lago Men's Golf Club Championships

Gentlemen,

The DLMGC Championships will be held on Saturday and Sunday, March 29 and 30 at the Del Lago Golf Course. As of this writing, 34 of us have met the qualifications standard of having participated in at least 8 events since October. There are several of you that are within one to three more events to qualify which will put the qualified field at about 42. You have until March 22 to meet the 8-event requirement, and we have 9 events remaining on the schedule. There will be three flights in which to compete, and your Handicap Index as of March 24 will determine your flight.

The flights are Championship and playing from the GOLD tee boxes. The Gold Tees will be slighted modified for holes 6 and 15 being on the back end of the silver teeing ground. The B flight playing from the Silver and C flight playing from the Green/Silver combination tees. The handicap indexes that we will use are 9.0 and under will be the Championship Flight. The handicaps from 9.1 to 15.0 will be Flight B and 15.1 and above will be the C Flight. You can opt to "play up" if you would like. If you want to compete to be the Club Champion, you must play in the Championship Flight and win the Gross side of the competition.

The tournament fees are \$100 per member. That covers both days of competition. The club will be adding \$240 per flight to the distributions making the potential payouts over \$5,000. There is daily competition and overall and the Flight Championships are based on the two days. You are able to win on the Gross side or the Net side but not both and you will get the higher amount depending on your scores. The payouts will be slightly higher on the Gross side. There will be Gross and Net Skins PER FLIGHT as well for each day.

The club we are working on the details for Saturday and Sunday regarding providing food and those details will be forthcoming once we have the information we need.

We will also be distributing the “pool” money on Sunday of the Championships. For those of you that may not know what the “pool” money is, for each event we set aside \$2 per player to be paid out at the end of the season. The pool is distributed to the top 25 point getters on a proportional basis. The club will be adding a minimum of \$300 to the pool so that the pool is at least \$1,800. As of this writing, the amount in the pool is \$1,398. We have 9 events remaining so it is highly likely that the pool will exceed \$1,800.
