

2024 Team Championship

ACTIVITIES and FORMATS

Dates: September 7th and 8th

Entry Fee: \$150 per player or \$300 per team

Registration Opens: August 19th at 5:00am -

Closes September 1st at 5:00pm

Eligibility: Players must have a minimum of 3 qualifying events

Handicaps: Maximum of eight (8) stroke differential between team members

Formats: On page 2 and Friday Putting Contest on page 3

* * * * - BEFORE YOU TEE OFF* * * * * *

PRO SHOP –<u>Saturday</u> = Range Balls Only= Small Bucket = \$4.00 > *Carts are FREE paid for by DRGA* <u>Sunday</u> = Players will pay for carts (\$5 per player) and small bucket of Range Balls = \$4.00.

OPTIONAL TEAM BUY-IN - \$200 PER TEAM <u>Friday</u> - Optional Team Buy-in can be paid at Friday Putting Contest Saturday - Optional Buy-in must be paid before your tee time

1. Saturday = NET Day Money - \$40.00 per team *Payout = 1st & 2nd Place Per Flight (75% - 25%)

2. Sunday Skins = \$40.00 per team for Gross & Net Skins

* Net Skins – Maximum of 18 strokes

* Partners cannot cancel each other's skins.

3. **Balance of \$120** = will be allocated to the Total Net Scores of each flight. **Payout will be 50% - 30% - 20% per Flight.*

All Players will receive one (1) lunch after their Saturday round.

PAR 3 – CONTESTS

CLOSEST TO THE PIN – \$100 per team will be awarded for each hole

HOLE-IN-ONE PRIZES * Par 3

Each day, one designated hole will be selected for the \$500 prize. All other par 3's will remain at \$200



FORMATS

SATURDAY – ROUND ONE

Holes 1 - 9 = Scramble

Both players tee off and then select the better ball on each shot. Except for on the green, the selected ball may be marked and replaced by both players within 1 Club length from the original marked position No Nearer to the Hole. Both players will play from this new spot. On the green the club length distance does NOT apply. All putts must be putted as close to the original chosen position as possible. All putts must be holed out.

Any inadvertent hole outs or tap-ins cancels your partner's opportunity to putt.

Holes 10 - 18 = Modified Alternate Shot

Each player will tee off and then select the best shot. The player who did not hit the selected shot will then hit the next shot; the shots will continue to alternate until the ball is holed. Once the tee shot has been selected that ball will be the ball "in play" throughout the completion of that hole, with **NO LIFTING OR REPLACEMENT OF SELECTED BALL** unless defined under the rules of golf.

SUNDAY - ROUND TWO

Holes 1 - 9 =Best Ball

A golf competition format consisting of two-person teams where you and your partner play your own golf ball on each hole. Teams will compete against the field, within their flight, using the better **NET** score of the two players. Scoring should include both **GROSS** scores on the team's scorecard. A third score will be shown as the best ball **NET** score. Should a player "pick up" and not finish a hole, an "X" will be shown as his/her **GROSS** score. When one team member can post a score, the other player need not finish the hole. Because there are two (2) players on each team, one player can be penalized without the other player being affected. However, time penalities will affect the team.

Holes 10 - 18 = Team Combined Net Score

Two Person team competition with limitation between players handicaps in accordance with specified tournament, where each player plays their own ball through the entire 9-hole round according to USGA and DRGA local rules. Scoring should include both **GROSS SCORES** on the team's scorecard. Official Scorer will calculate **NET SCORES**.

NEW NOTE

A player (team) must not move the ball from one type of turf condition to another. For example, the ball may not be moved from the rough to the fairway or the fringe to the putting green even if the ball is no closer to the hole.
