Membership in ILGA requires joining the Arizona Golf Association (AGA).

Handicap only memberships will be accepted but are not eligible to play in league play on Thursdays.

You must pay the yearly ILGA dues before playing in any ILGA event.

NOTE: Yearly payment of green fees at IronOaks does not automatically make you a member of ILGA.

ILGA requires members to join online through the AGA <u>www.azgolf.org</u> and does not accept checks or cash, **memberships must be entered online on the AGA website, and look for Ironwood WGA (Women's Golf Association)**. Refer to the Online ILGA Membership Instructions on the ILGA website.

Dues for 2025 are payable online starting 10-1-2024.

Anyone that does not have access to a computer can contact the Handicap- Membership Chairperson, Betty Lauer for assistance.

ILGA On-Line Membership Dues – 2025 The AGA no longer offers an early renewal discount for 2025.

*A If you are a multi-member, for example: joining both ILGA and OLGA online, or ILGA and another AGA league, you must pay full AGA dues at each club. The AGA multi-member rebate will be automatically discounted when your second online membership is processed. You will be charged full price for the first membership and \$15 for any additional <u>full year</u> memberships.

If you do auto renewal and are a multi-member, it is best to have each membership renewed on a different date to make sure that you get the multimember discount that the AGA provides.

NOTE: All members will be published in the Member-Roster with information taken directly from when you joined or renewed your AGA membership. Please provide all information requested on the application. You must notify the ILGA Handicap Chair by email if you do not wish to have your information published in the 2025 ILGA Member-Roster, or if you have a second email that you want used in the Member-Roster. All AGA and ILGA correspondence will go to your GHIN email.

<u>TEES:</u> All players play from the yellow tees, unless you request to play from the silver tees at the beginning of the membership season. This request is FOR THE YEAR. If you meet the rule of 95 (age + HC index = 95 or more) you are eligible to submit a sign-up sheet, applications are in the ILGA scorecard box.

NOTE: Tee selection will not apply to Major Tournaments (ILGA CUP, Club Championship). You may, however, play the Silver Tees and win your flight but not be the overall tournament winner.

ILGA sponsors several events such as Swing for Hope and our Member-Guest Tournament. If you are willing to volunteer to help on an event, please contact a board or committee person to volunteer.

SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP: Is for former ILGA members who are no longer able to play golf but would like to attend the ILGA luncheons and receive emails on club activities and newsletters. **The cost is \$10.00, there is no application, put a check made out to ILGA in an envelope addressed to Betty Lauer. On a piece of paper include your name, address, email, phone number and month and day of birth, (year is optional). This information will be published in the Online Membership Roster.**

ONLINE – ILGA Membership Instructions

Renewing Members: Login to your AGA account profile or go to the ILGA website https://ironwoodlga.azgolf.org and go to the MEMBER INFORMATION tab, then click on the highlighted line JOIN ILGA HERE. For the AGA website, click on the "JOIN/RENEW" box and follow the instructions.

New Members: Go to the Arizona Golf Association AGA website at <u>www.azgolf.org</u>. On the home page, click on the red box "JOIN/RENEW" at the top right page. It should take you to a page that says CLUB DIRECTORY, on the left there is a field that says: "Search by:" Under Club Name, enter Ironwood, Under City enter Chandler, Under Filter: Women Only. Click on the red box "SEARCH" and that should bring up the option IRONWOOD GOLF CLUB WGA. Click on the red tab "JOIN/RENEW". A white box will appear that says: "Please confirm that you'd like to join/renew at Ironwood Golf Club WGA". Click on the red box "PROCEED" and continue to follow the instructions.

BIRTHDATE: A valid date of birth is required, including year of birth. PHONE #: Enter the number you want to be contacted at if necessary.

If you are joining as a **NEW ILGA** member and have not had a **GHIN** before, you can join online **BUT** you **MUST** submit scorecards representing 54 attested holes of golf from any course or courses. The scores may be a combination of 9 or 18 hole rounds. The score cards must include Name, <u>Date, Score, Course Slope & Rating and must include the tees that you played from</u>. After completing the online AGA membership, the ILGA Handicap Chair will contact you with instructions on how to provide the minimum of 54 holes scorecards. Once we have entered your scores, you will get an email notifying you of your acceptance for ILGA membership.

If you are a **NEW HANDICAP ONLY** member and have not had a GHIN # before you will need to submit scores (see above) and we will input them for you on the GHIN website. You will only be able to enter the scores online after we have notified you of your acceptance and you have received you GHIN # and Local #. A link to post scores is provided on the ILGA website at <u>www.ironwoodlga.azgolf.org</u> or you can go directly to the GHIN posting site at <u>http://www.ghin.com</u>. Create an online e-profile, login and enter you scores. There is also a computer at the Ironwood Pro Shop that will allow you to post scores. Handicap Only members are not eligible to play in league play on Thursdays but can play in the Member Guest Event with an ILGA member.
