

GENERAL LOCAL RULES FOR SUN CITY

AREAS COVERED IN LARGE LANDSCAPE ROCKS (1" OR LARGER)

On ALL Sun City courses, these areas are NO PLAY ZONES. Play from these areas is prohibited and player must take relief. No Penalty.

NON-TURF DESERT AREAS INCLUDING AREAS COVERED BY CRUSHED AGGREGATE ROCK.

Desert areas including areas covered by Crushed Aggregate Rock are played as the general area. No relief without penalty is available.

YOUNG TREES IDENTIFIED BY STAKES ARE NO PLAY ZONES.

Young trees identified by stakes are NO PLAY ZONES. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, player must take relief under Rule 16.1f

PUBLIC ROADS

All public roadways are deemed to be out of bounds and any ball that crosses over a public road is out of bounds, even IF said ball comes to rest in another part of the course that is in bounds for another hole.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

A device that measures distance ONLY may be used for all play. A measuring device designed to gauge or measure other conditions (eg: gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc) is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is DQ, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE AND DISTANCE

When a player's ball has not been found OR is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed under Model Local Rule E-5 for two penalty strokes.
