Key Tabs are displayed at the top of the web site and each of those pages have content that can be scrolled through.

Home Tab: A page dedicated to recent and upcoming events with contact info at the bottom of the screen.

Calendar Tab: This tab is the center of the new site. Everyone should take some time to get familiar with this Tab. Scrolling down members will see every single event listed for the entire season. Click on an event and members will see tee times and results. When a member clicks on that button, it automatically takes a member to a Golf Genius Page, just for that event. To see Times or Results just click on either in the red bar.

Members Tab: This page is dedicated to members only and is password protected. When member clicks on this button additional buttons will appear. Members only Join/Renew and Application, For members; only contains contact info for all of our members. The password is **dont3putt**. Join/Renew takes members directly to the AGA site and application is for new members. From the Members Tab there is a drop down which includes Big Sister info.

Remaining Tabs are fairly intuitive and have very thoughtful links to additional info as warranted or deemed useful.

The new website is impressive and will be an important tool for our club. Polly urged everyone to ask questions and/or provide feedback as she continues to work on the site. The site has been made possible in partnership with AGA which is so much appreciated,
