

What is A Ringer Tournament?

A Ringer tournament is one in which a player's postable score is recorded by the Ringer Chair, and then on each succeeding play date her Ringer scorecard is updated with any lower scores ending with one 18-hole score total - her individual best score for each hole over a period of multiple rounds.

Our Ringer season is from January through the end of April, will break for the summer, and resume November 1 to December 31. The Ringer is divided into flights (A, B, C, D etc.) of equal or near equal participants in each flight with A being the lowest handicap index.

Ringer winners from the previous year will be announced and payouts distributed at the January luncheon.
