TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTIONS

☐ Eclectic Tournament	
	The Eclectic Tournament is an 18-hole individual event played over 2 consecutive rounds. The better score (from the 2 rounds) for each hole is your Eclectic 18-hole score. Winners include the overall low gross and net champions, as well as gross and net places in each flight. You do not need to play in both rounds to compete in this tournament. If we do not fill the entire tee sheet with Tournament players, we will have room for EOF (End of Field) players on 1 or both play dates.
☐ President's Cup Tournament	
	The President's Cup is a 36 hole, individual, stroke play tournament. Each player must complete all 18 holes on both days by recording gross scores for each hole. This is a NET Tournament. Only your Net 36-hole score will count for the competition. An overall Net champion will be crowned, along with places in each flight. You may choose to play from either the Green or Gold tees. If we do not fill the entire tee sheet with Tournament players, we will have room for EOF (End of Field) players on 1 or both play dates.
☐ Partner's Tournament	
	The Partner's Tournament is a 36 hole two-person team stroke play tournament using Stableford Scoring. Each two-person team must be made up of PWGA members with USGA handicap indexes within 10 strokes of each other. Teams must play both days (36 holes) to be eligible for prizes. The format on day 1 is Net Better-Ball of the two team members. The format on day 2 is Net Combined score of the two team members. All play is from the Gold tees. Overall payouts will be to the low gross team, and the low net team. There will also be Flight payouts for net scores only. If we do not fill the entire tee sheet

with Tournament players, we will have room for EOF (End of Field) players on 1 or both play dates.

☐ Club Championship

☐ The Club Championship is a 36 Hole Stroke Play Competition to determine the annual PWGA Club Champion (Gross competition). There will also be Flight gross and net prizes. Each player must complete all 18 holes on both days by recording gross scores on the official scorecard. Any member in good standing with the PWGA is eligible to compete - however, you must have played a certain number of times (TBD each year) with the PWGA league to be eligible to compete in the Club Championship. To be eligible to win the Club Championship, you must play from the Green tees (Championship Flight). All other flights play from the Gold tees. If we do not fill the entire tee sheet with Tournament players, we will have room for EOF (End of Field) players on 1 or both play dates.

☐ AZGolf Women's State Medallion Tournament

□ AZGolf hosts a statewide Women's tournament called the State Medallion, typically held in January each year. Participating clubs can send 1 team of 2 to compete in the event. Each season the PWGA holds 4 State Medallion Qualifier play days to determine the winning team of 2. Each participant best 2 qualifying scores count. The Low Gross winner (playing from the Green tees) and the Low Net winner (playing from Green or Gold) will represent the PWGA at the following years AZGolf Women's State Medallion Tournament.
