

Women's Club and PEM Golf Course specific rules (Local Rules)

USGA Rules of Golf govern Women's Club play. In addition, the following local rules apply at PEM:

1. RED STAKED AREAS

THE COURSE HAS NO OUT-OF-BOUNDS

All golf balls that leave the boundaries of the course shall be deemed to have come to rest in a red staked penalty area. The player should proceed by applying the red staked penalty area rules contained in the USGA rules of golf with the following exception:

- If a player's ball enters a red staked area that is also on a resident's property, the ball must **NOT** be played from the resident's property.

- 2. BUMP** – Lift, clean & place (place within 6” of original location, no closer to the pin) is allowed anywhere on the course EXCEPT on the greens.
- 3. DESERT** – Desert/Road areas on holes 1, 2, 5 and 6 are to be played as it l (lift, clean & place still allowed). This area is standard for the course and is not considered to be abnormal course conditions. The dirt area that leads in to the cart path on holes 4, 8, and 17 are to be treated as cart paths as well – proceed by applying the USGA rules for ball being on cart path (one club length from the “path” to nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole).
- 4. FAIRWAY DIRT/BARE SPOTS** – Bare dirt in FAIRWAY (only in fairways, not in rough) can be treated as ground under repair – one club length, nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole).
- 5. GREENS** – All putts must be holed out during Women's Club play (no gimmes).
- 6. PACE OF PLAY** – Please play ready golf and shoot for a 4-hour round. Keep up with the group in front of you.
- 7. GOLF COURSE** – Repair all ball marks on greens and sand divots. If you don't know how, please ask someone who does.
