Brenda Hopkins called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

MINUTES

Cathie Anderson read the minutes of the March 18, 2024 meeting. Sue Bonnett moved the minutes be adopted as read. Kathy Kocurek seconded. CARRIED.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Shannon Anderson was not present. There were no new expenses. The Current balance from last meeting is \$6,459.45. The treasurers report will be read at the next meeting when Shannon returns.

TOURNAMENTS

Signups will start today for the Margaritaville Invitational which will be held on Tuesday, November 19, 2024. Linda Rupley is chairman and stated that there will be a morning snack bag and lunch will be included. The fee this year has increased to \$85. If you have a golf membership (either year round or 5 month), the cost is \$40. Linda passed around a signup sheet for Raffle basket requests. This is an independent tournament fund raiser so raffle baskets need to be donated. The game will be 4somes with the card game. She will be moving our positions on the card from last year so the game will be different for everyone.

Dec 6 will be the Santa tournament. We are sponsoring Toys for Tots and ask that everyone bring an unwrapped toy for donation. There will be a costume contest for best santa or xmas costume.

Our New Golf Pro introduced himself – Barry Hernon. He gave us a brief description of changes he would like to see happen – new grass behind homes on the course, an irrigation fix, and a new Golf Shop and Bistro. A new acid machine has been approved to clean sprinkler heads. Christine and Scott are on board. They currently have a few marshalls that are alternating times they will be on the course. For now we need to have the 90 degree rule in effect. Also handicap carts no closer than 10' from greens. This will save wear and tear on the course later in the year. Rich has been doing an amazing job with maintenance of the golf course; aeration, tines, and top dressing. We will need to call the pro shop 24 hrs in advance to cancel our tee time for leagues. If you are sick or it is pouring rain you can call in the morning to cancel. It becomes hard for league organizers to manage the tee sheets. Habitual golfers who cancel for other reasons will incur a no-show charge. Brenda reminded everyone that if the course is open the women will play.

HANDICAP CHAIRMAN

Reminder to everyone to record their scores hole by hole and complete by Wed. evening. At today's registration you need to let them know if you are playing the red or gold tees.

You can hit out of red stake areas or take a 1 stroke penalty and 2 club lengths from the edge of the staked area no closer to the hole. Gail also suggested we download the USGA rules of golf app for easy access to ??? on the rules.

Gladys will have the tee sheet for tomorrows round a little later tonite and asked for everyone's patience. The Invitation to play gets sent out on Tuesday afternoons at 3:30 and will close on Saturday at 10 am so she has time to let the pro shop block off our times. You need to confirm 3 times when you respond playing or not playing.
