

ROADRUNNER 2025 TOURNAMENT FORMAT

THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

The tournament is divided into ten 6-team flights with flights determined based upon the total combined World Handicap System handicaps of the team members regardless of the tees selected for play by the team members. The flighted competitions feature five 9-hole Match Games so that each team will have the opportunity to play a Match Game against all the other teams in their respective flights.

HANDICAPS

Individual and team handicaps will be determined using USGA GHIN indices and World Handicap System guidelines to calculate them based upon the tees selected by each team member for the different daily courses and formats of play. 9-hole handicaps are derived from the adjusted 18-hole handicaps of the team members

DAILY PLAY- SWITCHING OPPONENTS BETWEEN 9-HOLE MATCH GAMES

Play will be conducted using 7:30 am and 10:00 am 9-hole shotguns on Thursday and Friday. Scorecards for both 9-hole matches will be handed out at the beginning of play each day. Teams will switch opponents between 9-hole matches on Thursday and Friday, and **SIGNED** scorecards for the first round each day will be collected by tournament staff after the round. To facilitate the Team Switching after the first rounds, the scorecards for Round 2 will list the names of your opponents and the starting hole for the second round. Switching is not necessary on Saturday because teams play only one 9-hole match that day. All Teams will return to the Golf Shop area after completing their final matches each day to turn in their scorecards for that match

RAIN-OUT PROVISION

In the event matches get cancelled for weather or other adverse conditions, unplayed holes will be declared ties for scoring purposes.

THE COMPETITION MATCH PLAY SCORING FORMAT

The competition format is Match Play and scoring will be 2 points for winning a hole, 1 point for tying a hole and 0 points for losing a hole in each Match Game. The team with the most points wins the match and the winning team shall be awarded Two (2) points in the TEAM STANDINGS. In cases of ties, each team shall be awarded One (1) point in the standings. Losing teams receive Zero (0) points. Teams will be competing only against the other teams in their flights for prize money based upon points awarded in each of their Match Games.

THURSDAY FORMAT OF PLAY (two 9-hole Match Games)-TEAM SCRAMBLE

Requiring three drives per player in each 9-hole Match Game. Since only one score is recorded, the first ball in the hole, even if by mistake, counts as the team score for the hole. Net scores will be used to determine team point scores on each hole. 25% handicap for each player.

FRIDAY FORMAT OF PLAY (Two 9-hole Match Games)-TEAM BETTER-BALL-OF-TWO SHAMBLE

Requiring three drives per player in each 9-hole Match Game. Both players tee off on each hole and the team selects the drive they wish to use to finish the hole individually. Net scores will be used to determine team point scores on each hole. 75% handicap for each player.

SATURDAY FORMAT OF PLAY (One 9-hole Match Game)-TEAM BETTER-BALL-OF-TWO

Competition is Better-Ball-of-Two. Since only one score counts, teams will compare their best net scores to determine team point scores on each hole. 100% of handicap for each player.

SATURDAY MORNING HORSE RACE: A full-field Horse Race will be conducted immediately following completion of the morning 9-hole matches. This is a separate competition, and the results will not be included in the overall tournament competition. The Horse Race is explained on the next page.

ROADRUNNER 2025 HORSE RACE DETAILS

The HORSE RACE will be conducted on Saturday following completion of the morning 9-hole normal team matches. ALL teams will participate in the HORSE RACE. The teams will be divided into five HORSE RACE GROUPS. Each Group will compete in a 3-hole elimination to determine a single winner that will compete in the overall HORSE RACE finals. The finals will be a one-hole playoff to determine the Horse Race Champion.

The format for the HORSE RACE is a Chapman-style true alternate shot through the entire 3-hole elimination process. Whomever putts or chips last, the other teammate tees off on the following hole. Penalty for not following this procedure will result in a 2-stroke penalty. After each of the first two holes, 50% of the field will be eliminated either through best net score or a chip-off only in case of ties. The Groups Winning teams will be determined on the third hole by best net score or a *chip-and-putt-off* in case of ties.

The Winning Teams from each of the original five Groups will compete in a one- hole playoff to determine the Overall HORSE RACE CHAMPION. The winner will be determined by the lowest net score or a chip-and-putt-off in case of ties. Each of the final five participants will receive prize money but there will be no ties for the five paid positions.

Team Payouts: 1st - \$300, 2^{nd} - \$250, 3^{rd} - \$200, 4^{th} - \$150 and 5^{th} - \$100.

Team Handicaps: Team handicaps will be determined using The SMGA Alternate shot handicap adjustment of 60% of lower course handicap and 40% of the higher handicap, and teams may receive a team "pop" on one of the playoff holes due to this adjustment. Each golfer will play from their tournament assigned tees.

ROADRUNNER 2025 TOURNAMENT PRIZE MONEY

The tournament is divided into ten flights of six teams per flight and teams will be competing for prize money only against the other teams in their respective flights. Each team will play five 9-hole Match Games in the tournament. Prize money will be paid to winners as shown below. Since there is only one 9-hole Match Game on Saturday, there will not be a separate prize for Day Total that day.

FLIGHT PRIZE MONEY PAYOUTS

9-HOLE MATCH GAME PRIZES: \$30 to the team winning their match

FLIGHT DAY PRIZES: Prize money will be awarded to the top three teams *in each flight* with the highest combined point totals for the day on Thursday and Friday. The team prizes will be: \$60 for 1st Place; \$50 for 2nd Place; and \$40 for 3rd Place.

FLIGHT OVERALL PRIZES: The top three teams in total points for all three days *in each flight* will receive the following prizes: \$60 for 1st Place; \$50 for 2nd Place; and \$40 for 3rd Place.

TIES will be broken by card-offs conducted by the golf professionals using the standard USGA methodology.

TOURNAMENT OVERALL PRIZES

The top three teams in total points *from all flights in the overall tournament competition* will receive the following prizes: \$200 for 1st Place; \$150 for 2nd Place; and \$100 for 3rd Place. If necessary, ties will be broken by Team Chip-and-Putt-offs involving both team members on the Tucson #9 green following the Horse Race on Saturday afternoon.

PRIZE MONEY NOTE: Prize money winnings will all be paid in the form of SaddleBrooke One Pro Shop Gift Cards.

Flight Winners will also receive FLAGS signed by all of the players in their flight.

OVERALL TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

The team with the highest total point score will be declared the Champions of the Tournament! The Players names will be inscribed on the RoadRunner Tournament Plaque and each player will be given a traditional Saddle Trophy to keep for one year as a memento of their accomplishment. The Saddle Trophies must be returned to the tournament annually for presentation to future winners.

VOLUNTARY WAGERING

There are two ways to wager voluntarily during the tournament, however, as always- "NO WAGER-NO WIN".

WAGER #1: The \$100 TEAM BET

(Place bets Wednesday night at the Stag Dinner or before tee off on Thursday morning)

Teams may bet \$100 on themselves to win cash in the Team Bet pools for each flight. Money from the Team Bet Pools *for each flight* will be used to pay cash prizes to the top three overall finishers in each flight. Since the wagers are voluntary, the sizes of each Flight Pool will not be determined until after wagering closes before tee time on Thursday morning. Payouts will be based upon the total pools, respectively, but the payout rates will be: 50% for 1st Place, 30% of 2nd Place and 20 % for 3rd Place.

WAGER #2: INDIVIDUAL WAGERS BETWEEN TEAMS

You may place individual wagers between teams. A "Pigeon Sheet" will be furnished to allow teams to note any agreed upon wagers with other teams. These wagers are made and are the responsibility of the individuals involved.

SCORING NOTE

We will be using **Golf Genius** in addition to scorecards for scorekeeping throughout the tournament. The scorecards will include the **Golf Genius GGID number for accessing Golf Genius on your cell phone**, and one player in each foursome must enter all team scores in **Golf Genius** after completion of each hole. Two signatures are required on the official scorecard. The card turned in must be signed and attested by one player from each team. If your competitors have to withdraw for any reason, or in case of a rules dispute, please call the Pro Shop (520) 825-2505 and every effort will be made to resolve the issue. When the first matches are completed on Thursday and Friday, please sign the scorecards properly before moving on to the starting hole for your second match. First match scorecards will be collected by tournament volunteers on the course during your second match.

PACE OF PLAY

Since teams will be switching opponents after each 9-hole Match Game, Pace of Play is extremely important to ensure timely completion of play each day. For example, if your partner's score has won or tied a hole, and you cannot improve your team's standing on that hole, please pick up your ball and prepare to move on to the next hole.

DRESS CODE

Dress throughout the tournament is casual. Proper golf attire on the course during tournament play and luncheons. For the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening, slacks and a collared shirt are acceptable for the men (jackets and ties are not required) and informal cocktail attire for the ladies. In the Vistas Restaurant, street shoes are required (no golf shoes).

GENERAL RULES

Local Rules: SaddleBrooke local rules will apply throughout the tournament. For reference, they can be found online at: http://www.saddlebrooke.org/course-local-rules.

When the specific game allows a ball to be moved or placed, follow these rules

Balls not on the green shall be played within one club length from the same course conditions as the original location of the selected ball (fairway, fringe, rough, sand, etc.) except when using USGA or Local Rules to move the ball and penalty strokes are applied, if required.

Balls on the putting green shall be played within one putter head length of the selected ball not nearer the hole.

Other: IN THE SCRAMBLE FORMAT, where only one score is required for the team score, the first ball holed, even if by mistake, will be the team score for that hole.


