

SADDLEBROOKE ETIQUETTE

- Fill all divots, repair all ball marks, rake all bunkers – Leave the course as you would like to find it.
- Play ready golf – Keep up with the group in front of you.
- Please play each course within 2 hours and 5 minutes – Check-in with the starter at the turn.
- Please adhere to the daily and seasonal cart path restrictions.
- Be courteous to fellow golfers and staff.

LOCAL RULES:

- USGA Rules shall govern all play.
- New Local rule / Stroke & Distance: When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds or lost (excluding Penalty Areas); the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. For two penalty strokes, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or another ball in this relief area (see Rule 14.3):
 - a. Ball Reference Point: The point where the original ball is estimated to have: Come to rest on the course, or last crossed the edge of the course boundary to go out of bounds.
 - b. Player can move then drop a ball from that point all the way to the fairway (up to 2 club lengths into fairway) and drop the ball at knee height.
- Out of Bounds - White stakes, property lines or curb lines.
- Decorative rock areas - **MUST** take free relief under Rule 16.1.
- First Bridge on Catalina #5 is obstruction (free swing relief only).
- Bridge on Catalina #7 is obstruction (free swing relief only).
- Players **MUST** take mandatory free relief from freshly planted trees and tree wells.
- Drainage inlets or outlets not in a penalty area are obstructions.
- If ball comes to rest within 2 club lengths of an immovable obstruction on your line of play and the obstruction is within 2 club lengths of the green, the player is entitled to free relief under Rule 16.1b.
- NO PLAY ZONES are marked with red stakes with green tops - no play permitted, 1 stroke penalty and relief. (Rule 17.1)
- All of our local rules are on the SaddleBrooke One website under Golf.

LIGHTNING POLICY:

In the event of lightning all play shall cease. Players should seek protection in a large permanent building, fully enclosed vehicle, or lowest elevation area. Golfers who continue to play when lightning is near risk serious injury and play at their own risk and responsibility.

In an effort to conserve drinking water, the golf course is irrigated with reclaimed water. Do not drink.
