The full calendar as of January 1st 2025 will be posted on the website shortly and I will try and highlight a month at a time as I write to you during the upcoming season so you know what's scheduled and you can mark your personal calendars accordingly.

IMPORTANT ITEMS

There will be two changes to Tuesday Play Days in 2025. Payouts for 2024 were \$12, \$10 and \$8 because of a large end-of-the-year carryover from the 2023 budget. However, for 2025 the payout amounts will be returned to \$10, \$8 and \$6 for both individual and team games for budgetary reasons. If TPD payouts are running well under budget, the amounts will be revisited later in the year. The other change is that the Board voted to discontinue the optional Skins game played on Ace Days because of the additional work for both the TPD Chair and the Pro Shop. Comments made that Skins should be either Gross or Net but not both were also taken into consideration.

My sincere thanks to Cathe Kropp and Janice Hoover for all their work in putting together the 2025 Membership Handbook! You will receive your handbook at our January luncheon but if for some reason you cannot attend, you can contact Peggy Bakos, our Membership Chair, and she will arrange to get it to you. Thanks to Peggy and her team also for their efforts in putting the handbook packages together. These include the payouts for the birdies and better, chipins and eclectic option awards (kudos to Carol Bidwell and Judy Fick for handing all the money) and Cathe Kropp for securing the Rules bag tags and USGA Rules document which we hope you will find very helpful. Hole in One payouts, eagle and break pins, etc. will be distributed by Connie Culley and Sally Drennen. A big shout out to Suzanne Stone-Griffith for

all her work as Handicap Chair this past year - she does a great job in monitoring all things handicap and we are so encouraged with the response from our members in accomplishing an over 90% compliance with the recommended posting on the day of play. When members fell out because of oversight or other reasons, a gentle reminder from Suzanne brought everyone back into compliance. Any questions regarding how to post, particularly those of you who are new to our organization, or if you need to take a leave of absence for medical or other personal reasons, reach out to Suzanne and she will assist.

I want to make special mention of Christine Smith who was our Charity Representative for 2024. When I approached her to see if she would like to remain in the position for another year, she told me that there was still a lot of work we could do on behalf of the Sister Jose Women's Center and if that was our charity of choice for 2025, she would be delighted to continue with this much appreciated volunteer effort. The blanket drive in December/January has been a great success, thanks to the enormous generosity of our membership. Further initiatives will continue during the year and Christine will bring those to our attention at our upcoming monthly meetings.
