Hello to all SBWGA League Members:

Well, February was such a busy month with play days and meetings that I just couldn't get to writing a newsletter earlier than this. So, I decided to combine February and March this time and may do so in other months where there is little activity and not a lot to report.

IMPORTANT ITEMS

You will have noted that we had a change in the line-up of Officers on the SBWGA Board. For personal reasons, Ruth Irving our elected 2025 Secretary, advised me that she very reluctantly needed to submit a letter of resignation. The Board was very sorry to receive this notice and thanked Ruth for her services over the past couple of months. Janice Hoover, the 2024 Board Secretary advised that she would be willing to return to the Board and so at its meeting on February 4, her name was considered as a replacement for Ruth per the SBWGA-18 ByLaws, Article IV Officers – "To fill an unexpired term, an officer may be elected by the current Elected Board members at any of its meetings." Janice was voted in to fill the unexpired term as Secretary. We thank Janice for stepping up and agreeing to fill the vacant position.

At our General Meeting and Luncheon held on Feb 3, I reported on a meeting with the stakeholders regarding reinstatement of the Skins Option on Ace Day. I was tasked with requesting by a show of hands to see if in fact our members like the option and would be in favor of adding it back to our schedule of options. As those of you who were in attendance indicated a firm "yes", your SBWGA Board addressed the matter at its monthly meeting the next day and voted to rescind its prior decision to eliminate the Skins option on Ace Day. Effective with the March 25 Ace Day, the game will be re-established.
