



SBWGA 2025 QUAIL CLASSIC INVITATIONAL

Conditions of Competition

GENERAL:

All play is governed by the Rules of Golf of the R&A USGA as modified by the Local Rules of SaddleBrooke One Golf and SBWGA Standing Rules (detailed at the end of this form).

FORMAT:

The format is a Scramble and a Shamble. Neither round is postable because participants are not playing their own ball from the original spot in which the ball was hit. Additionally, Miracle Putts and Mulligans are being used both days.

Monday, Day One: Scramble

- Both players tee off. For every shot, the preferred ball will be selected. From that spot, the players drop a ball within one club length from the chosen ball not on the green, or within one putter head when on the green. This is repeated for each shot until the ball is holed out. Record one team score.

Tuesday, Day Two: Shamble

- Both players tee off and select the best drive. Each player drops a ball within one club length of that drive and plays her own ball into the hole. Record both scores.

A minimum of six (6) drives are required from each player each day.

COURSES:

Monday, April 7: Tucson/Catalina Links with 8:00 am shotgun start

Tuesday, April 8: Saddlebrooke/Tucson with 8:00 am shotgun start

TEES:

All participants will play from the RED tees.

HANDICAPS:

The handicap index in effect on April 3, 2025 will be used.

The playing handicap for the Scramble will be 35% of the handicap index for the lower handicap player and 15% of the handicap index for the higher handicap player. The playing handicap for the shamble will be 85% of the handicap index of each player.

Handicap differential between partners may not be more than 10 strokes. If the playing handicap between the two players is greater than 10 strokes, the playing handicap for the player with the higher handicap will be reduced.

SCORECARDS:

Monday: Check in at the Registration table outside the Pro Shop where you will be given your scorecard which will include the Golf Genius ID to be used for Day One. Tuesday: Scorecards will be with the starter. Scorecards will include the Golf Genius ID to be used for Day Two.

Please arrive no later than 7:30 am both days to reduce cart congestion and allow all players practice time.

AWARDS:

Winners will be determined by combining the scores of the Day One Scramble and the Day Two Shamble rounds. Low Gross and Low Net winners in each flight will be awarded.

RESULTS:

After your round each day, return your scorecard to the scoring table in the Vistas dining room. One team member and one competitor must sign the scorecard. This will be compared to scores entered during the round via Golf Genius. **DO NOT POST YOUR ROUND.**

TIE BREAKERS:

The recommended USGA tie breaker system with a scorecard playoff will be used to process any ties (last 9, 6, 3 and 1 holes).

M&Ms (MULLIGANS AND MIRACLE PUTTS):

Mulligans: Can be used to redo any shot on the course or on the green. Each player will have one Mulligan each day.

Miracle Putts: Once your ball is on the green, you may pick it up, count one stroke and declare your ball to be holed out. Each player will have one Miracle Putt each day.

PACE OF PLAY:

Please keep up with the group in front of you as there is a very full field, and we want each member and guest to enjoy their round without having undue delay due to slow play. Marshalls will be in attendance so follow their instructions if they speak to the group.

VII. SBWGA-18 LOCAL RULE

SBWGA-18 Local Rule: No player may take a gross score higher than nine (9) on SaddleBrooke Course, Hole #2. When a player reaches a gross score of nine (9), it is mandatory that they pick up their ball and record a gross score of nine (9). This will not disqualify a player from any tournament, ACE Day, or any games played on Tuesday Play Day.

SaddleBrooke One Golf Local Rule: Decorative Rock (as indicated on the back of the scorecard). Players must take free relief under R&A USGA Rule 16.1.
