Sunday, April 6, 3:30 Registration, 4:00 pm to 6:30 pm Party

REGISTRATION FEE

Registration is \$450 per two-person team for SaddleBrooke One Annual Members. The committee worked hard to ensure a wonderful experience while dealing with increased food costs and green fees. This year we are including \$20 worth of Miracle Putts and Mulligans for each team in the registration fee, so the increase from last year's cost of \$420 per team is only \$10.
