

WWGA Reminder

WWGA November Event – Member/Guest November 10, 2024 @ Aguila Golf Course

For the **November 10th** outing, we will be having our 4th Annual Member/Guest event! Your registration coupon and \$50 entry fee (\$10 prize money and \$15 for food and snacks for each player) are due to our Treasurer by **Saturday, November 2nd**. As always, you will be responsible for green/cart fees. Green/cart fees for guests will be approximately \$87 (less expensive if they have the Phoenix Card). We will have tee times starting at 7:20 a.m. and teams will be paired by flight as much as possible. It is expected that people will pair up in carts. For those members that prepay their prize money, you will need to pay the additional amount needed for your guest and food by the November 2nd deadline (see instructions below and check the prepaid list. Any prepaid money that you have not used this year has been applied to your Member/Guest fee, so your amount might be reduced). **ONLY THE FIRST 30 REGISTERED MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS WILL BE ABLE TO PLAY!** If you have questions, please send them to the WWGA email box.

When you register, you will need to communicate the full name (first and last) and GHIN number of your guest (anyone who is NOT a member of WWGA) so they can be entered into the system properly and their handicap can be used. For those guests that do not have a handicap, please communicate that as well. Guests may be male or female, young or experienced, good golfers or hackers. What matters is that you have fun and play quickly! Men and children will be assigned to an appropriate set of tees, based on their handicap. We will be playing net Stableford, so everyone can contribute. Points will be won based on each player's net score for each hole. Points for each team member will be combined. This event will be flighted based on the combined playing handicap for the team from the assigned tees. Teams will be paired by flight as much as possible. Members will get their winning payouts (50% of each flight) in pro shop credit, as usual. Each guest will walk away with a gift of some kind (thank you to those that donated items for gifts!), with the higher scoring team guest getting first choice and working the way down the scoring list until everyone has something. Guests must be present to win, so please hang around until your entire flight is off the course and the results can be calculated. Lunch will be in the event room at the clubhouse, paid by WWGA and your entry fees. Other food and beverages can be purchased in the restaurant at your own expense. If you have questions, please send them to the WWGA email box.

The only reason our entry fee is low is because of the raffle we have to raise the money to pay for our event! Raffle tickets will be sold **BEFORE ALL GROUPS TEE OFF!** The drawings will be done as soon as all golfers tee off, so you can collect your prizes as you come off the course. Bring your money and be ready to purchase your tickets when you first arrive. Write your name on your ticket (the one you put in the raffle), just in case you can't find your own copy later. Your, and your partner's, participation in the raffle is greatly appreciated. We have golf bags, rounds of golf, a wine basket, seat cover, pictures, and cash! (Thank you to those that donated items for the raffle!)

Please confirm how much you have prepaid by looking at the attached prepaid list. In the left most column it will give you how much money you have on the books. You need to pay the difference between what is showing and the required \$50. If you are not fully paid, you need to use Zelle or Venmo (putting your guest's full name and GHIN number in the notes section) to send the balance of the \$50 entry fee to Working Women's Golf Association using the club email address (phxwwga@gmail.com). If you are unable to use electronic payment, make arrangements with Carol Sumner to mail a check, made payable to WWGA. If you need to CANCEL and you have already paid, please send an email to the WWGA email by the evening of **Sunday, November 3rd** (the last day to cancel and carry over to December). Pairings will be available by the end of the day Saturday, November 9th. If you have questions, please send them to the WWGA email box.

NOTE: For Sarah Asta, Joanne Powell, Kelly Smedley and Jackie Smylie - you must play in this event to be eligible to play in the Club Championship in December.
