Club Championship, December 14 & 15, 2024 @ Cave Creek Golf Course
Ghost Holes, December 15, 2024 (Sunday Only)

It is time for the Club Championship!! It will be held Saturday and Sunday, December 14th and 15th at **Cave Creek Golf Course**. Below is a list of the members who DID NOT qualify to play (you must have played with the club at least 4 times during the calendar year). Those not qualified for the Club Championship are welcome to sign up and play in the Ghost Holes event on Sunday only. The standard \$10 prize fund fee will get you registered for this event. The Club Championship AND Ghost Holes events, played on Saturday AND Sunday (must play both days) is a \$20 prize fund fee.

For the Club Championship, played on Saturday and Sunday, December 14th and 15th at **Cave Creek Golf Course**, your \$20 prize money (includes Club Championship and Ghost Hole events) payment is due to our Treasurer by Saturday, December 7th. If you are not prepaid, you need to use Zelle or Venmo to send Working Women's Golf Association (using the email address) a \$20 electronic payment. If you have paid, then just show up and play golf!! You can confirm if you are paid by checking the prepaid list attached or posted on the WWGA web site. Please check the Prepaid list to verify if you have any money on the books. "CC" before your name means that you have prepaid the \$20 to play in the Club Championship. "GH" before your name means that you have prepaid the \$10 to play only in the Ghost Holes event on Sunday only. If you are eligible and would like to play in the Club Championship, you will need to pay an additional \$10 (a total of \$20 for December). If you would like to play only in the Sunday, December 14th event of Ghost Holes, your \$10 prize money payment is due to our Treasure by Saturday, December 7th.

If you have already paid and want to CANCEL from either or both events, you must contact WWGA through the WWGA email address by the evening of Sunday, December 8th, as a

headcount is due to the course first thing Monday morning (so unused tee times can be sold). Any cancellations after Sunday will forfeit their prize fund payment.

The Club Championship will consist of an overall low gross winner, overall low net winner and one gross and one net winner from each flight. For the overall low gross and low net winners, ties will be broken with a sudden death playoff. Players will start the playoff on a hole agreed upon by the Tournament Committee and the golf course staff on the last day of play. Play will continue until a winner is determined. If you are in contention for an overall prize that goes to a playoff, but you leave the course, you will forfeit your place in the playoff. For the flight winners, ties will be broken with a scorecard playoff, utilizing the USGA recommended method for breaking ties.

We are currently scheduled for tee times starting at 7:30 am on Saturday and 9:36 am on Sunday at Cave Creek Golf Course. Please respect the course and other players by being there at least 30 minutes prior to your start time. That will allow for everyone to pay, get loaded onto a cart with your playing partner, and be ready to tee off on time. Feel free to walk.

Pairings for the Saturday round will be sent out no later than Thursday evening. Pairings for Sunday will not be sent out until late on Saturday, as pairings for Sunday are made based on Saturday's results. Please be patient, as there is a lot of work that goes into this process of determining Saturday's results and pairings for Sunday and the fact that we are running 2 totally separate events at the same time.

Attached, please also find a copy of the UPDATED WWGA schedule for 2025 (August date change). If you have not yet renewed your membership in the WWGA, please go online to the Arizona Golf Association (azgolf.org) and renew. Doing this before December 31 will save you some money.
